HIGH-RISK PERSONNEL TACTICAL CARBINE (HRPTC) is a 3-day / 24-hour off-the-shelf course that was developed to provide advanced combat marksmanship skills to high-risk personnel tasked with the responsibility of utilizing a tactical carbine / assault rifle in the performance of their duties.

This comprehensive live-fire program will challenge the most competent of combat marksmen and is designed and developed to increase individual tactical proficiency and bring combat effectiveness to a new higher level.

Instructors selected to teach this course are among the most competent and experienced combat marksmanship instructors in the world, with extensive real-world experience in select Tier I U.S. Special Operations Command (USSOCOM), government, and elite law enforcement organizations. Instructors possess extensive combat / counter-terrorism experience in high-risk regions, such as Iraq and Afghanistan.

PREREQUISITES:
