



MARITIME SECURITY FOR MILITARY, FIRST RESPONDER, AND LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL (MSLEP)

MARITIME SECURITY FOR MILITARY, FIRST RESPONDER, AND LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL (MSLEP) is a 5-day / 40-hour off-the-shelf course that was developed to provide the requisite skills-set for military, first responder, and law enforcement personnel with little or no previous maritime background to conduct their respective duties aboard maritime vessels, in port facilities, and elsewhere in the maritime environment in accordance with the requirements of the Maritime Transportation Security Act of 2002. MSLEP will provide the foundational skills for personnel tasked with the demanding duties of providing anti-terrorism, force protection, and physical security services for maritime vessels, ports, and facilities in high-risk, non-permissive environments.

The primary objective of this course is to provide military, first responder, and law enforcement personnel with the unique skills and abilities in order to detect, deter, and mitigate maritime-based terrorist and/or criminal element threats through proactive strategies. Instruction will be taught to trainees utilizing a combination of lecture and hands-on situational training exercises.

COURSE CONTENT includes, but is not limited to the following:

- Case studies
- Threat analysis
- Inspection of maritime vessels, terminals, and facilities
- Responding to crises involving threats of terrorism and actual terrorist attacks
- Monitoring and controlling access to facilities and vessels
- Interviewing, examining, and credentialing transportation workers and facility personnel
- Conducting surveillance and participating in undercover operations
- Tracking and interdicting suspicious cargo, persons, vessels, and vehicles
- Recognizing and detecting the presence of bombs, explosives, and Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD)
- Interaction with Vessel Security Officers, Company Security Officers, Facility Security Officers, and relevant federal, state, and municipal-level agencies
- Performing threat, risk, and vulnerability assessments
- Security planning
- Contingency planning
- Tactical diagramming
- Operational planning
- Situational Training Exercises (STXs)

ACCREDITATION:

Recce Group is currently seeking accreditation and approval of the MSLEP Course through the Maritime Administration (MARAD). Recce Group is approved and recognized by the South Carolina Criminal Justice Academy (SCCJA) as an institutional service provider of training. Our InstSP number is 301.

PREREQUISITES:

Minimum age for enrollment is 18. Course is restricted to U.S. government agencies and armed forces, U.S. Department of State-allied agencies and armed forces, law enforcement, public safety, security, tactical emergency medical support organizations, and maritime company, vessel, and facility operator entities. Students must provide credentials verifying affiliation with above-listed organization(s). The acceptable forms of identification are as follows:

- U.S. Merchant Mainer Document issued after 3 February 2003
- STCW 95 Certificate (with embedded photograph)
- U.S. Passport
- U.S. Armed Forces Identification Card
- Photo identification issued by U.S. federal, state, and local government agencies
- Driver's license with photo of the driver issued by a U.S. possession or commonwealth

Students should be in excellent physical condition and have no debilitating medical conditions or any medications that could affect physical ability and judgment.

METHOD OF EVALUATION:

Students must score 75% on a final written examination and successfully complete all performance objectives.

MANDATORY STUDENT EQUIPMENT:

- Tactical uniform or casual attire
- Notebook and writing utensils

OPTIONAL STUDENT EQUIPMENT:

- Laptop computer w/ portable printer
- Hand-held compass and/or GPS
- Sunglasses / sunscreen
- Miscellaneous tactical equipment (as per unit SOP)

STUDENTS RECEIVE:

- Student manual
- Graduation diploma upon successful completion of all performance objectives.
